. Steamboat Explosion .- The Steamer United States, when the hoiler exploded had but 30 pasmengers instead of 60 as the New York letters at first stated. Mr Ephraim Wooster, said to belong to Derby, Connecticut, jumped overboard, and was taken up alive but died soon after. Mr Ilirain Clark, merchant of New Haven, and a boy belonging to the boat are missing. Mr C. jumped overboard. Five men belonging to the boat

were hadly scalded, of whom, three black men,
have since died. Capt. Peecher was slightly
scalded in his feet. None of the passengers who
