White Man Lynched in Arkansas.

BRINKLEY, Ark., Nov. 8.—At an early hour this morning Z. C. Cadle, a white man, was lynched by a mok of between ten and fifteen people. Cadle, in an altercation, had cut Policeman J. C. Cox, who died shortly afterward. About 2 o'clock this morning a mob secured entrance to the jail, and, taking Cadle out, shot him four times and hanged him to a telephone pole. The Coroner's jury to-day rendered a verdict that Cadle came to his death from lynching by parties unknown.
