Tupamaro Leader Seized In Downtown Montevideo

MONTEVIDEO, Uruguay, June 22 (UPI)—One of the top 10 Tupamaro guerrilla leaders, Jorge Manera Lluveras, was arrested today on a downtown street, police sources said.

Mr. Manera Lluveras, 36, a former engineer for the state telephone company, had been sought since last September when he escaped with 105 other Tupamaros from the Punta Carretas maximum security prison. He was spotted by a police patrol.

One Government source said Mr. Manera Lluveras was second in importance to Raul Sendic, founder of the Tupamaros, who is still at large.
